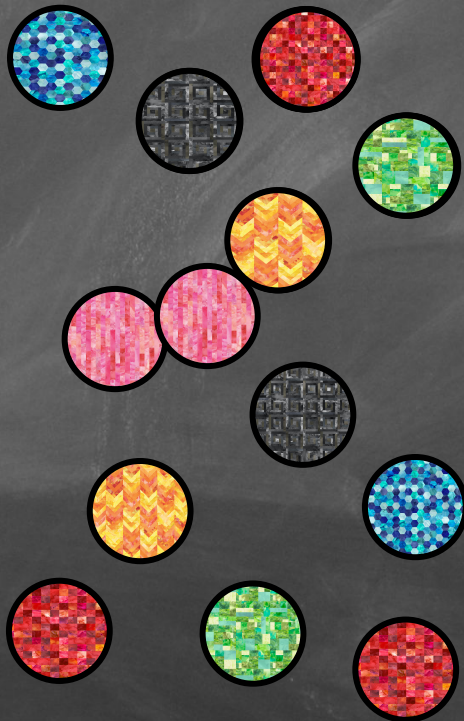

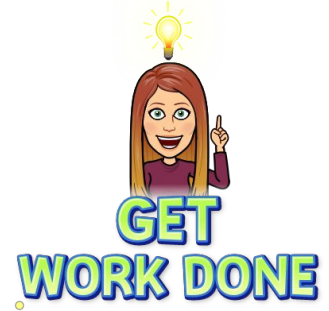

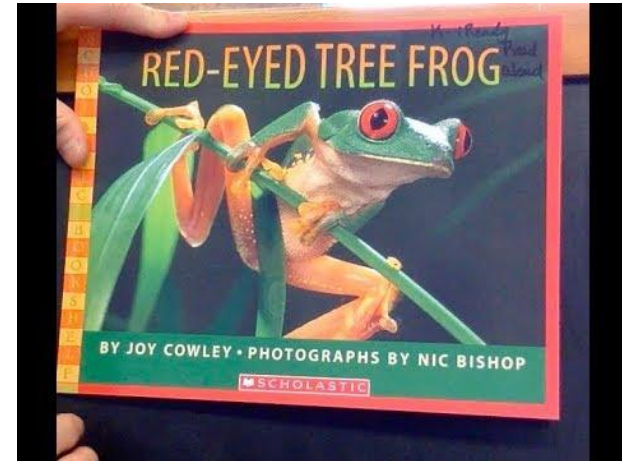
Analyze details means to tell the Main idea of a text and the important details that support the main idea.

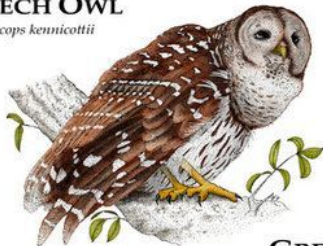

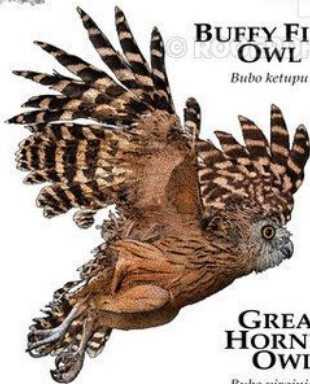

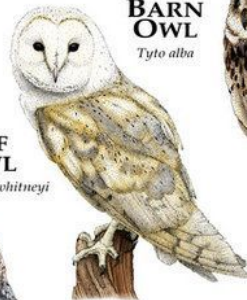

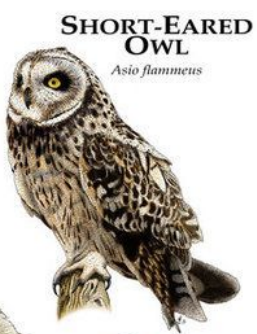
