BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The administration (myself, Mr. Perry, and the four principals) have been working to review improvements we can make in our schools to increase the safety and security in our building.

Below is a summary of the improvements that we intend to make this summer:

Rolling Hills (\$10,020):

- Eliminate a large portion of the glass at the front entryway.
- Cut an entry from the front vestibule into the office so that during the day visitors will not be able to access the school without checking in at the office.
- Install a proximity key-fob entry system at three entrances. All other entries will be locked with only the principal having a key.
- Controlled entry system (camera/buzzer/intercom) for visitors.

Willow Vista (\$8,386):

- Cut an entry from the front vestibule into the office so that during the day visitors will not be able to access the school without checking in at the office.
- Install a proximity key-fob entry system at three entrances. All other entries will be locked with only the principal having a key.
- Controlled entry system (camera/buzzer/intercom) for visitors. Middle School (\$8,935):
 - Eliminate a large portion of the glass at the front office.
 - Install a proximity key-fob entry system at four entrances. All other entries will be locked with only the principal having a key.
 - Controlled entry system (camera/buzzer/intercom) for visitors.

High School (\$6,468)

- Install a proximity key-fob entry system at four entrances. All other entries will be locked with only the principal having a key.
- Controlled entry system (camera/buzzer/intercom) for visitors.

In addition, we will be installing an upgraded fire alarm system at the Middle School (\$32,500) and in a non-security matter, we will be making required ADA changes to the football field bleachers (\$34,900.)
