Subject: Consider Approval of Revision to Policy FD (Local)

Background Information:

Graham ISD [Policy FD \(Local\)](#) addresses Eligibility for enrollment in the District, or Admissions. Trustees are asked to review this policy and will be asked to consider language to be added as follows:

Students Not Enrolled

A student enrolled in a private school, including a homeschool, shall not be eligible for concurrent enrollment in the District nor for participation in curricular or extracurricular activities. [See EEL and FM]

Administrative Consideration:

SB 401 requires school districts to opt out of allowing homeschooled students to participate in extracurricular and cocurricular activities. Graham ISD Trustees voted to opt out at the August 6, 2025 Board meeting. Graham ISD is currently listed on the [School Districts That Have Notified UIL That They Have Opted Out of Homeschool Participation](#). By adopting this language in policy, Graham ISD would not have to take action on SB 401 again until such time that the District decided to allow Homeschool participation. Graham ISD would not have to annually vote to opt out of homeschool participation.
