# Superintendent Recommendations for Designation as a District of Innovation

### **Recommended Parameters:**

- Texas Education Code §25.0811 (EB LEGAL): First Day of Instruction
  - o Directs that instruction may not begin before the fourth Monday in August, except in certain circumstances (not applicable to RRISD).
- Texas Education Code §25.0812 (EB LEGAL): Last Day of School
  - Directs that the last day of school may not be scheduled before May 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Texas Education Code §21.003 (DBA LEGAL): Certification Required
  - Directs that a person may not be employed as a teacher, teacher intern or teacher trainee, librarian, educational aide, administrator, educational diagnostician, or school counselor by a school district unless the person holds an appropriate certificate....
- Texas Education Code §21.055 (DBA LEGAL): School District Teaching Permit
  - Directs that a school district shall seek the commissioner's approval when employing an individual to teach in a subject other than Career and/or Technical
- Texas Education Code §21.057 (DBA LEGAL): Parental Notification
  - Directs that a school district notify parents within 30 consecutive school days when their child's class is not being taught by an appropriately certified teacher
- Texas Education Code §25.112 (EEB LEGAL): Class Size
  - Directs that a school district in grades Kindergarten thru Fourth grade may not enroll more than 22 students in a class.
- Texas Education Code §25.113 (EEB LEGAL): Notice of Class Size
  - Directs that a school district granted a class size reduction waiver notify the parents of the students in the class of the waiver.
- Texas Education Code §38.101 (FFAA LEGAL): Physical Fitness Assessment Req.
  - Directs that a school district annually assess the physical fitness of students enrolled in grade three or higher.
- Texas Education Code §38.103 (FFAA LEGAL): Reporting of Physical Fitness Results
  - Directs that a school district shall report the results from the Physical Fitness Assessment to the agency
- Texas Education Code §25.081 (EB LEGAL): Minimum Minutes of Instruction
  - Directs that students must attend 75,600 minutes of instruction; does not provide an exception for pre-kindergarten students.



#### **Recommended Committee:**

- Utilize the District Site-Base Decision Making (SBDM) Team to develop the innovation plan.
  - This committee is one of two options available under the District of Innovation statute. The other option is to create a completely separate committee. The SBDM will be responsible for developing a proposed school calendar, which is then presented to the Board of Trustees for approval. Board Member Kelly Venable will also be a part of the SBDM.
    - Note: The Innovation Plan may be amended in the future. In order to amend the Plan, a majority of the DEAC would have to vote to approve the amendment, as would two-thirds of the Board of Trustees. See Tex. Educ. Code §12A.007.

## **Proposed Timeframe:**

- 1. Board Approves Resolution (December 12)
- 2. Public Hearing by Board (December 12)
- 3. Board Appoints Committee (December 12)
  - o Board outlines parameters for plan (see above)
- 4. Committee Meets (January 9 January 31)
  - Consider exemptions
  - Create proposed Innovation Plan
  - Post proposed final Innovation Plan on RRISD's website (30 days: February 1 March 2)
- 5. Send proposed final Innovation Plan to the Commissioner of Education to fulfill notification requirement (February 1)
- 6. Committee holds public hearing and meeting (requires SBDM majority approval) (March 6)
- 7. Committee votes on proposed final Innovation Plan (March 6)
- 8. School Board holds public hearing and meeting (March Board Meeting)
- 9. School Board approves proposed final Innovation Plan (requires ⅔ majority) (March Board Meeting)
- 10. Notify Commissioner of Education of Innovation Plan approval (immediately following approval)
