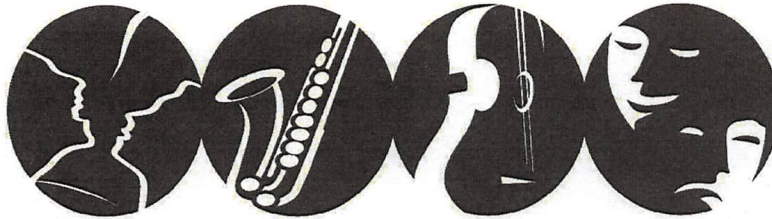

This contract between _____ (Student/Parent) and the Fremont High School Performing Arts Department ("School") commits the Student to participate in the department's trip, to Anaheim, CA scheduled for March 30-April 3, 2022. Parents and students are asked to initial next to each section of this contract, indicating full understanding of the commitment.

- _____ 1. The cost of the trip is estimated at \$1000 inclusive, per the itinerary
- _____ 2. The price of this tour is determined by a minimum of 40 students. Should a student need to cancel their participation in this trip for any reason, it is the responsibility of the student to immediately communicate this change in status to the director. The committed parties accept that any funds submitted prior to this notification may not be eligible for refund.
- _____ 3. I understand that in order to reserve my spot, this signed contract and a ***non-refundable*** deposit of \$300.00 must be returned to my director by January 28 .
- _____ 4. I understand that all payments for the trip will be made on time and per the following schedule. If I am late with a payment and have not made appropriate arrangements with my director, my tour place will be forfeited. The final payment for this trip is due by March 11.
- _____ 5. **I understand that once full payment is made, it may not be eligible for refund in the event that the School cannot get a refund from those it has paid for services on this trip (including, but not limited to, the charter bus company, the hotel, theme parks, and any other vendor to which the School pre-paid for services.). I agree to hold the School and Weber School District harmless in the event of a catastrophic situation which causes the School to cancel the Performing Arts Tour. A "catastrophic situation" shall include, but not limited to, act of nature (including any epidemic or outbreak of pandemic disease), storm, flood, earthquake, fire, family emergency, act of government or state, and any other situation or event out of the reasonable control of the Parties. I understand that to the extent that the School can get refunds for cancellations, the School will refund me proportionate to what the School is able to recoup. I understand that if the School is not refunded, I will not be refunded.**
- _____ 6. I understand that I must meet UHSAA eligibility in order to travel. Eligibility will be determined by 3rd Quarter grades and attendance. Requirements are 2.0 GPA, no more than one F and no more than .75 attendance credit loss. No refunds will be issued as a result of student eligibility.
- _____ 7. As a participant in the FHS Performing Arts tour, I will represent my choir, my school, and the Weber School District with dignity and pride, which will be made evident in my behavior throughout all stages of the trip. I understand this agreement has been established to maximize the safety and security of each person. Please understand that in cases of severe infractions, at the discretion of the directors or an administrator, students will forfeit their right to privileges and activities on the trip and be sent home at the parents' expense.

ITINERARY:

To ensure adequate driver preparation, we require a detailed finalized itinerary listing all stops with complete addresses and anticipated timing at least 21 days prior to departure. For your safety, Teton Stage Lines will operate your trip in accordance with US/Canada DOT Hours of Service Regulations. Any changes or modifications to the itinerary must be submitted to Teton Stage Lines prior to your trip to ensure these safety regulations are not violated. The Teton Stage Lines driver will be furnished with your final itinerary and will be instructed not to deviate from it. Changes or modifications to the itinerary may result in additional charges

DRIVER RESTRICTIONS:

By US DOT law, drivers may not drive more than 10 hours during any 15 hours on duty without an 8 hour off duty period. During off duty periods the coach shall not be occupied by passengers. If itinerary requires more than one driver, additional drivers may be employed onboard or exchanged en route for an additional charge.

DRIVER LODGING:

Chartering party is responsible for individual hotel rooms for drivers on overnight trips. Overnight accommodations should be made at same hotel as charter party if possible (with motor coach parking) (1) driver per room at a national chain hotel.

PRICING:

All charter pricing does not include anticipated highway tolls based on the itinerary submitted. Parking, entrance fees and other miscellaneous expenses are not included in the charter details. All charter pricing is pending receipt of and accurate and timed itinerary. Teton Stage Lines reserves the right to revise pricing based on times, date, mileage or any detail that has changed since the initial inquiry or contract. In addition, pricing is based on availability; the price quotation is valid for 30 days of the original date of quotation. Teton Stage Lines reserves the right to adjust price prior to receiving a deposit for the trip. Charters that extend longer than contracted for will be charged an hourly rate of \$100 per additional unit per hour.

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

Teton Stage Lines prefers payment by check or money order and accepts all major credit cards. Cash is accepted if paid in person. Please identify group name, contract number and trip date on all payments/correspondence.

DEPOSIT/PAYMENT POLICY:

A \$250 or up to 10% deposit is required within 21 days of booking to confirm your charter. All charters must be PAID IN FULL BY DUE DATE OR 30 DAY'S PRIOR TO DEPARTURE UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE STATED BY TETON STAGE LINES. If paid by Credit Card a 3% charge will be added.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

A full refund will be given if cancellation is received 30 days prior to departure date unless otherwise stated on this contract. Trips cancelled 29 days to 7 days prior to trip date may forfeit their deposit or total of up to 20% of charter. Trips cancelled 7 days or less prior to trip date will be charged the full cost of the charter price.

GRATUITY:

Customary gratuity ranges from \$1 to \$5 per person, per day. Gratuities are not included in charter price, unless other arrangements were made. Gratuity should be paid in check or cash directly to coach operator or escort. By request, we can add gratuity on to charter total and will be passed in full to the coach operator or escort for your charter.

EQUIPMENT:

Teton Stage Lines maintains a fleet of safe, modern motorcoaches. In the unlikely event of a mechanical problem, delays due to weather or traffic conditions, or other causes beyond Teton Stage Lines control, Teton Stage Lines reserves the right to take whatever precautions deemed necessary to ensure the safe completion of your trip.

LIABILITY:

Carrier will not be liable or be caused to be held for damages for any reason whatsoever, for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, inclement weather, road conditions, acts of God, public enemies, authority of law, quarantine, perils of navigation, air traffic delays, riots, strikes, the hazards or dangers incident to a state of war and any other condition beyond its control and does not guarantee to arrive at or depart from any point at a specified time. Carrier will endeavor to maintain the schedule submitted by the chartering party but same is not guaranteed. If any of the above mentioned conditions make it, in the opinion of Teton Stage Lines, inadvisable to operate Teton Stage Lines vehicles either from the place of origin or any point en route, the carrier shall not be liable therefore or be caused to be held for damages for any reason whatsoever Teton Stage Lines reserves the right to lease or charter equipment from other carriers to fulfill this charter agreement. In the case of a good will adjustment for a service interruption, under no circumstances will a rate adjustment, refund, or credit exceed the amount of the charter. Teton Stage Lines will be allowed up to 5 Hrs. to find a replacement bus.

DAMAGE & CLEANING FEES

Damages to coaches inflicted by chartering party will be billed at repair value to contracting entity. Excessive cleaning required by irregular use of coach interiors will be billed up to \$250 per vehicle cleaned. Contracting party is responsible to pay damage costs within 14 day terms.

BAGGAGE:

Teton Stage Lines will exercise all reasonable care, but is not responsible for loss or damage to baggage carried on its vehicles.

LOST ITEMS

Please do not leave personal items onboard coach at any time. Teton Stage Lines is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items. It is the responsibility of the group leader to perform a final coach check at last drop-off. As a courtesy to guests Teton Stage lines will stores lost and found items for 30 days at which point we will discard of the item. Teton Stage Lines will ship them for \$10/regular mail or \$100/next day delivery.

SMOKING & ALCOHOL

At no time is smoking of any type permitted aboard Teton Stage Lines coaches. A stop can be made as requested by group leader at any time for smoking. The use of alcoholic beverages onboard the vehicle may require a security deposit and must be consumed responsibly. No glass containers will be allowed onboard. We appreciate our passengers ending their trip with the coach interior in the same condition in which it started.
