TOPIC: Approval of Bid Results for Paving Projects at Roosevelt

Elementary, Franklin High School, and Stevenson High School

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the recommendation from the Owner's Representative, Plante Moran CRESA, to approve Nagle Paving Company, Novi, Michigan for paving projects at Roosevelt Elementary, Franklin High School and Stevenson High School in the amount of \$997,360.00, plus a contingency of \$100,000.00 for a total of \$1,097,360.00 and authorize the Superintendent or her designee to negotiate and execute final contracts.

RATIONALE:

This is a planned Sinking Fund project intended to provide pavement repairs and improve traffic flow at Roosevelt Elementary, Franklin High School, and Stevenson High School. The contingency originally discussed at the Committee of the Whole was to be 15%; however, after further consideration of the scope of the project and past contingency amounts, the contingency proposed for summer 2018 paving projects has been lowered to 10%.
