Re: Course Addition – AVID Elective 12

I respectfully recommend the addition of AVID Elective 12 for the 2026-2027 school year. This 1 credit course would be offered as a year-long unweighted elective to 12th grade students. This course is a continuation of our offerings of the AVID elective.

The rationale for the course addition is aligned to Strategy 1.4: *Establish the instructional and academic identity of the school district to increase the focus on holistic student development and preparation for post-secondary success in a variety of career pathways.*

AVID, Advancement Via Individual Determination, is a research-based program that prepares students for four-year college eligibility. The 12th grade AVID Elective course is the capstone junior/senior seminar course that focuses on writing and critical thinking expected of first- and second-year college students. In addition to the academic focus of the AVID seminar, there are college-bound activities, methodologies, and tasks that should be undertaken during the senior year to support students when they apply to four-year universities and confirm their postsecondary plans.

This course addition was discussed and approved by the Curriculum Coordinating Council.
