In accordance with Texas Election Code, Section 2.053(a), the governing body of a political subdivision may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office after receipt of a “Certification” that a candidate is unopposed. The “Certification of an Unopposed Candidate” is defined by Section 2.052 of the Election Code as follows:

Only one candidate’s name will be placed on the ballot for a particular position, and
No candidate’s names will be placed on the listed write-in candidates for the position.

District 1 has an unopposed candidate and there were no write-in candidates.

Recommendation

I recommend acceptance of the Certification of Unopposed Candidates for Big Spring Independent School District
