PROPOSAL details:

- 1. What is something that you would like very much to do for or with your students but you cannot currently afford to do it?

 I would like to purchase a variety of STEM activities for the classroom that students can access on a regular basis.
- 2. In 200 words or less, describe this project, listing the estimated costs of the items of the planned project totaling up to \$600.

I teach Kindergarten at Lulu Walker Elementary, a title one school. I have 24 energetic and curious students that love STEM activities. I have looked through multiple catalogs and online vendors to find some STEM activities that spiral with what we learn, enhance learning for those higher level thinkers and can still be used by those that are struggling with basic concepts. I have a list of 7 items that all the students in the class can benefit from. They range from the engineering part of STEM, the problem solving by manipulating and using math, some basic STEM kits that have some science experiments, to the very cool "decoding with a robot." These things can pique the interest of Kindergarteners and hold their attention while working in cooperative groups. I believe the addition of these items would really create an excitement for the sciences in my classroom.

The total for these 7 items is \$555. With shipping it will be \$600.
