The President announced that the Board of Education would next consider the adoption of a resolution providing for the transfer of \$1,200,165 from the Educational Fund to the Debt Service Fund pursuant to 23 ILL. ADMIN CODE 100.50.

## RESOLUTION RE: THE TRANSFER OF \$1,200,165 FROM THE EDUCATIONAL FUND TO THE DEBT SERVICE FUND PURSUANT TO 23 ILL. ADMIN. CODE 100.50

WHEREAS, the Illinois Administrative Code (23 ILL. ADMIN. CODE 100.50) authorizes the permanent inter-fund transfer of money to the Debt Service Fund when revenues or other sources of funds are pledged to pay debt service on any long-term debt; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education finds and determines that it is necessary to pledge One Million Two Hundred Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$1,200,165) in the Educational Fund to pay debt service on a long-term debt; specifically, to pay debt service on certain of the School District's outstanding Capital Appreciation Bonds, Series 2001-A; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education is now authorized to permanently transfer the sum of \$1,200,165 from the Educational Fund to the Debt Service Fund pursuant to 23 ILL. ADMIN CODE 100.50; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Education deems it advisable, necessary, and in the best interests of the District that \$1,200,165 be transferred from the Educational Fund to the Debt Service Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Geneva Community Unit School District No. 304, Kane County, Illinois, as follows: <u>Section 1</u>. The Board of Education hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true, and correct and does incorporate them into this Section 1 by this reference.

Section 2. That the Treasurer of this School District is hereby directed and authorized to transfer on or before December 31, 2018, the sum of \$1,200,165 from the Educational Fund to the Debt Service Fund.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
