

Member ______ introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

RESOLUTION PROVIDING LIMITED AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE & OPERATIONS TO SIGN CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statues §123B.52, Subdivision 2 provides school boards with the authority to authorize superintendents and business managers to sign contracts within adopted budgets, and

WHEREAS, numerous contracts of a routine nature need to be executed on a regular basis, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statues §123B.52, subdivision 1 stipulates that contracts made without compliance to this section can be found to be void,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the school board authorizes the Superintendent and Director of Finance and Operations to execute contracts within the adopted budget as approved by the school board provided that any transaction in an amount exceeding the minimum for which bids are required must first be specifically authorized by the school board and must fulfill all other applicable requirements.
