BOARD POLICY

The Board desires to provide safe ingress and egress to each of its schools and a safe parking lot(s) at each of its facilities. Only students in grade nine and above with valid drivers' licenses are authorized to drive vehicles to school and to park on campus.

The superintendent is authorized to adopt procedures consistent with this policy.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

- 1. All student vehicles must be identified with a parking decal issued by the school Tupelo High School. The current parking decal must be permanently affixed to the student's vehicle in accordance with the instructions provided.
- 2. A reasonable charge may be assessed by the school for the issuance of a parking permit. decal.
- 3. Students and their parents/guardians must agree to comply with the District's random drug testing policy for students who participate in athletics and/or extracurricular programs, and/or who wish to drive to and park on campus.
- 3. Students who violate the rules for driving or parking on campus will be subject to having their permission to drive and park on campus suspended or revoked.
- 4. Students must park only in assigned parking lots and in those areas specifically identified for student parking.
- 5. Students who are suspended from school are not authorized to drive or park on school District property during the term of suspension.
- 6. The principal, or designee, is authorized to issued citations and collect reasonable fines for campus driving or parking violations by students.
