Teaching & Learning

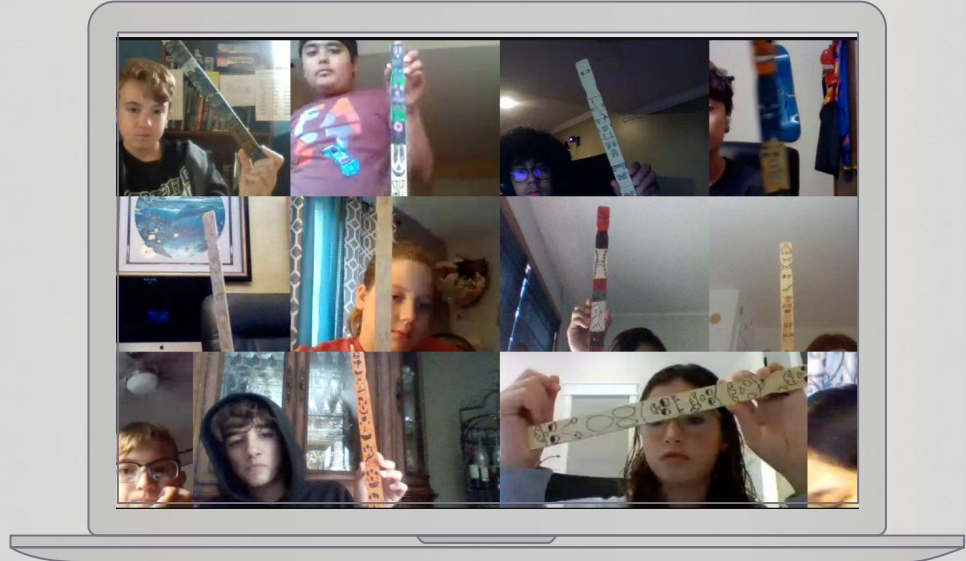
During COVID-19
