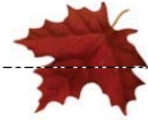
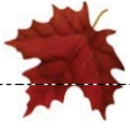
LOST AND FOUND

IMMUNIZATIONS

Attention Parents/Guardians of all 7th & 8th graders. Oregon law requires that all children attending public school are up-to-date on their immunizations (shots) unless they have a medical or religious exemption on file. The 7th & 8th graders are due for a Tdap (if their last dose of tetanus was given 5 or more years ago). Please check with your doctor or the Josephine County Health Department located at 715 NW Dimmick St., Ph. # 541-474-5325. They are open for **immunizations Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 pm (open during lunch) closed on Fridays**.
