## BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Operation Connectivity is a statewide effort coordinated by TEA to allocate CARES Act funding for the purchase of elearning devices to enable remote learning during the COVID-19 pandemic.

## ITEM ADDRESSED:

We recommend to ratify the Interlocal Acquisition Agreement between Wylie ISD and Region 4 Education Service Center for Operation Connectivity allowing for the purchase of 500 Chromebooks and 400 Ipads. The total cost of the devices is \$268,400 with Wylie ISD's portion being \$134,200.

Board ratify the Operation Connectivity Interlocal Acquisition Agreement with Region 4 Education Service Center.
