It is the desire of the Board of Education of Davis School District (Board) that each school or other facility within the District is given a name that lends dignity and status to the school or facility. The Board also desires to protect students, parents, teachers, and school administrators from over-commercialization and restrictions or requirements that are coercive, distracting, or disruptive to the educational process.

## Round 1 Input

January 12–21, 2026

Parents and students designated as living in the new school's boundaries received an email on January explaining the process. They were provided a link to a Microsoft Form for voting. They were given a chance to send in suggestions for the name of the new school.

- 717 Total emails were delivered
- 51 Total Responses
- The top common words appearing in suggested names:
  - Still Water (16)
  - Parkview (6)
  - Shoreline (6)
  - Discovery (4)
- Other unique names suggested:
  - Blue Heron
  - Juniper
  - Marshland Meadows

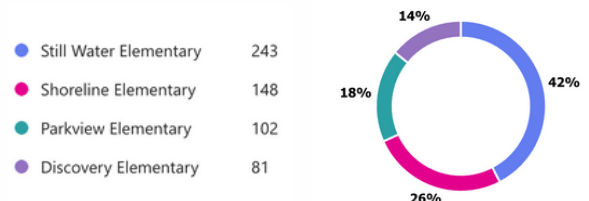
## Round 2 Input

January 22–30, 2026

Four names were selected from the suggested common terms and unique names submitted from the first round. The names to choose from were:

- Still Water
- Parkview
- Shoreline
- Discovery

A total of 579 votes were cast. Still Water Elementary was the top choice with a total of 243 votes - 42% of people who voted chose this option.
