




School Board Goals 2012-13

- Student academic achievement: Grades 2 though 8 will exceed the national mean growth target from Fall 2012 to Spring 2013 for math and reading as measured by NWEA.
 - Grades 3-8 have moved away from NWEA testing in favor of MCAs. NWEA results for grades 1 and 2 show students exceeding or at the national mean growth target. MCA scale math and reading scores exceeded the state mean proficiency.
- Increase secondary course offerings: The school board will review an analysis of secondary course offerings no later than February 2012.
 - o Completed. Board workshop conducted 2-23-12
- Capital Needs/Deferred Maintenance: The school board will reduce facility capital and deferred maintenance deficiencies by approving an action plan no later than July 2012.
 - o Completed. Bond referendum approved 11-6-12




