FNCE(Local)

House Bill 1481

The Board of Trustees must adopt a written policy prohibiting students from using personal communication devices (including cell phones and smart watches) on school property during the school day.



FD(Local)

A student enrolled in a private school, including a homeschool, shall be eligible for participation in extracurricular UIL athletic and academic activities in grades 9-12 only. Any other student enrolled in a private school, including a homeschool, shall not be eligible for concurrent enrollment in the District nor for participation in curricular or extracurricular activities.



FM(Local)

For eligibility of a private school student, including homeschool student, to participate in extracurricular activities, see FD(Local).



EFB(Local)

Policy EFB(Local) ensures the District provides a wide range of library materials for students and faculty that support student achievement and present varying levels of difficulty, diversity of appeal, and a variety of points of view.
