

Denton Independent School District
Technology Building Fiber Infrastructure Extension Purchase

April 28, 2020

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from HMI Utilities, LLC in the amount of \$160,700.39 for the extension of the District's fiber infrastructure from the Professional Development Center to the Technology Building located at 200 W. Congress.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

On March 24, 2020, the Board approved the GMP for the renovation of the new Technology Building at 200 W. Congress which will be serviced by this fiber infrastructure extension.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The renovations on the Technology Building, located at 200 W. Congress, are schedule for completion in July 2020.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Some of the materials involved in the project have an extensive lead time, so this purchase is a critical path for the project. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2013 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to bring the property at 200 W. Congress online as the new Technology Building.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quote from HMI Utilities, LLC in the amount of \$160,700.39 for the extension of the District's fiber infrastructure from the Professional Development Center to the Technology Building located at 200 W. Congress be approved.
