## Schools receive top ratings from TEA

To achieve "Recognized" standing, a school must receive 70 percent passing rates on all TAKS areas or 65 percent passing rate with required improvements, plus an 85 percent high school completion rate, 70 percent SDAA II passage rate, and a .7 percent or less dropout rate in seventh and eighth grades.
