BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS:

For a number of years, the superintendent's contract has included the use of a designated district vehicle. A 2006 Mercury Grand Marquis was purchased originally for this purpose. That vehicle now has 151,000 miles.

Bids were solicited for a vehicle from three local dealerships. A bid for a 2018 Ford Explorer with a purchase price of \$35,594 from Randall Ford, Inc. represents the best value among the bids submitted. In addition, the district will receive a \$1,400 trade-in credit for the Mercury Grand Marquis. As a result, the total cost to the district will be \$34,194.

RECOMMENDATION:

The administration recommends approval of the purchase of the vehicle as described above.
