Benefits

- Guaranteed scholarship upon successful completion of placement

Criteria

- Agreement between RAISE Academy and local business to facilitate the internship experience
- Must include an experience that links the student to livable wage employment
- 8 or 16 week experience option
- Mandatory scholarship upon completion of program
- Minimum of one hour per week of management mentorship
- Must be at least 16 years of age and a RAISE Academy student
