## PLAN OF ACTION

Blackshear exceeds the cap by two students at first grade bilingual. A new bilingual teacher has been added to comply with the 22:1 cap.
*Blanton exceeds the cap by one student at kindergarten bilingual. A waiver will be requested for this campus.

Burnet exceeds the cap by five students at grade four. A fourth grade teacher has been added and the classrooms are now balanced.

Dowling is over the cap by one student at grade two. One student will be moved to the LEP/NLEP classroom to comply with the 22:1 cap.

Gonzales exceeds the cap by three students at grade four. A fourth grade teacher has been added and the classrooms are now balanced.

Johnson exceeds the cap by two students at kindergarten. A new teacher has been added and the classrooms are now balanced.

Johnson exceeds the cap by seven students at grade two. A new teacher has been added and the classrooms are now balanced.

Jordan exceeds the cap by five students at grade one. Five students will be moved to a LEP/NLEP classroom to comply with the 22:1 cap.

Jordan exceeds the cap by four students at grade three. A teacher has been moved from another campus and the classrooms are now balanced.

Noel exceeds the cap by one student at grade one bilingual. A child not qualifying for bilingual services will be moved out of the bilingual class to the regular classroom.

Pease exceeds the cap by three students at grade two. A teacher has been moved from another campus and the classrooms are now balanced.

Ross exceeds the cap by four students at grade three. A bilingual resource unit was converted to a $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade self-contained bilingual classroom to comply with the 22:1 cap as well as comply with the bilingual exception.

San Jacinto exceeds the cap by five students at grade one. A first grade teacher has been added and the classrooms are now balanced.

Travis exceeds the cap by two students at grade two. A second grade teacher has been added and the classrooms are now balanced.
