

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
DENTON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING  
LOCAL REMOTE LEARNING PROGRAM**

September 28, 2021

**SUMMARY:**

This item requests approval of a Resolution written in response to Senate Bill 15, allowing Districts to operate a local remote learning program in accordance with the requirements set forth in Education Code 29.9091.

**PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Following the 2021 second special legislative session, Senate Bill 15 was signed by the Governor allowing local school Districts the opportunity to operate a remote learning program. A District may adopt a policy to exempt students from the minimum attendance requirements for class credit or a final grade for one or more courses offered under a remote learning program provided under Education Code 29.9091. This Resolution authorizes Denton ISD to operate a local remote learning program as permitted by law and employ specific instructional and attendance-taking methods when providing its remote learning program. This Resolution will apply to the 2021-22 school year unless the Board takes further action.

**FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:**

**BENEFIT OF ACTION:**

Approval allows the District to operate its K-8 Virtual Academy and be exempt from requirements regarding minimum attendance for its courses.
