Recommendation:				
Administration recommends that the Board approve UISD's application to the Texas Education Agency for a Course requirement waiver for "Advanced Engineering Design and Presentation".				
Rationale:				
This Course Requirement Waiver would make it possible for students in the Engineering Magnet to be able to fit Advanced Engineering Design and Presentation into their four-year plan by giving UISD the option to offer the course for a minimum of one credit, better meeting the needs of UISD students and our community.				
Budgetary Information:				
There is no impact on the budget.				
Board Policy Reference and Compliance:				

1. Give a brief narrative description of the requested waivers.

United ISD is requesting a course-requirement waiver to be able to offer Advanced Engineering Design and Presentation (2-3 credits) for 1-3 credits. Currently, this course must be offered for a minimum of 2 credits, making it difficult for some students to take advantage of this program because of the increased requirements of the "Four by four" graduation plan.

2. Does this district or campus plan reflect the need for this waiver? If yes, what is the specific objective impacted by this waiver?

**District Goal:** Continue to improve student achievement.

**Long-Range Goal:** To implement an academic program that will serve to improve student achievement in all areas of TAKS by reaching 90% by 2012.

**Performance Objectives:** United ISD will offer at least one section of the course listed above per semester at United High School.

4. Describe the plan to be implemented if the waiver is granted.


United ISD four-year plans are designed with the objective that all UISD students complete a rigorous and comprehensive curriculum. Due to the number of courses that four-year plans require for students, we need the course mentioned above to be offered for one credit. A one-credit course would better meet the needs of UISD students and our community and would allow students the flexibility of enrolling in these enrichment electives without having to allocate an entire 90-minute block for the entire year on the accelerated block schedule. Counselors will use the waiver information when pre-registering students for the 2010-11 school year.

- 5. How will granting this waiver help achieve the district or campus's objective? UISD students in the Engineering Magnet program will be given the opportunity to study and master computer software applications in a variety of engineering and technical fields.
- 6. Please explain how the school district or campus will evaluate the impact of the waiver towards meeting the district or campus's goal.

The campus will use PEIMS data to evaluate student enrollment in the course listed above.

7. Please specify the school years for which the waiver is requested, to a maximum of three years.
