## 31 Jul 2025: Crosby ISD JROTC Cadets Tour Fort Johnson Military Installation (Louisiana)

### **Background:**

- Army Cadet Command requires cadets to participate in 46 events a year to enhance their educational experience, academic achievement, and school / community pride.
- This tour allows military bound Crosby cadets to experience firsthand a typical day in the life of a soldier.
- Intent is for this contact to motivate them to continue or choose another path as they explore options after high school.
- Satisfies Crosby High School CIP Goal #5: Co-Curricular Activities. Crosby High School will develop Co-Curricular programs which enhance students' educational experiences, academic achievement, and school and community pride.
- This event not only addresses district goals and objectives but also addresses and satisfies JROTC Army requirements.

### **Mission:**

- **Who:** Two chaperones & 20 Crosby ISD military bound JROTC cadets.
- **What:** Tour Fort Johnson Military Installation and experience a day in the life of a typical soldier.
- **When:** Wednesday, 30 Jul 2025 (travel day); Thursday, 31 July 2025 (tour day).
- **Where:** Fort Johnson Military Installation (1591 Bell Richard Avenue, Building 920, Fort Johnson, Louisiana, 71459).
- **Why:** To allow military bound cadets to explore their future options by experiencing firsthand a typical day in / off their future.
- **How:** Cadets will leave on Wednesday during summer break, tour on Thursday and return on Thursday. Thus, zero impact to their school hours since entire travel and tour done during summer break.

### **Facts:**

- **Impact:** No impact to school hours since entire trip and tour done during summer break.
- **Cost:** \$6,210.34 with zero cost to cadet or chaperone and zero requirement for fundraising since JROTC extra-curricular funds used.
- **Transportation:** Fort Johnson is 176 miles away from Crosby High School – 3.5 hour one way bus ride. This is an out of state trip but closer than most of our in state trips; San Antonio 250 miles one way & Dallas 300 miles one way.
- **Travel Experience:** Crosby ISD JROTC participates in more than 140 events per year – zero incidents. Already toured Fort Cavazos (Killeen, TX – 215 miles) & Fort Sam Houston (San Antonio – 250 miles).
