E-Learning Days

If we have multiple inclement weather days - "Snow Days" - that result in school cancellations, we will be able to hold E-Learning Days to continue progressing forward in classes and eliminate the need to make up the day later in the year. The first weather day called will not be an e-learning day, simply a day with no school. The second and subsequent days will be E-learning days. Students will need to bring their device and schoolwork home with them and will need to be prepared to connect with school work through Google Classroom. Foley Intermediate School's E-learning plan is:

- Faculty will post a lesson/learning activity for each class no later than 10:30 a.m.
 - Students should plan for approximately 30 minutes of learning "work" per class (but must be engaged with the learning to do so).
- No live google meets will be required of students.
- Staff will be available via email between the hours of 10:30-3:20 for all students to answer questions, including setting up a Google meet with students.
- Faculty may set up a google meet for a class and invite students if appropriate to current needs, however, students will not be required to attend.
- Assignments will not be due until two days after the e-learning day to allow for those students with a lack of internet access or home responsibilities preventing them from engaging with schoolwork during the actual e-learning time.
- Attendance will be recorded by students engaging with the assignment and following teacher directions on Google Classroom prior to 3:20 p.m. the day of the cancellation.
