Identified needs (in order to narrow the gap)

- 1. Increase targeted ESL intervention/supports Work more 1:1 or small group pull-outs; push into more classrooms for "real-time" support
- 2. Increase engagement with parents of ESL population Strengthen connections between home and school
- 3. **Build use of specific strategies in regular classroom** Consciously use those strategies helpful to ESL students (benefits all)

- a. Addition of an ESL aide
- b. Shift admin staff (oversee documentation, LPAC, etc.)
- c. ESL teachers narrow focus
