Organize Your Student's Space

Whether you use a family area or have a room set aside for homeschooling, it is a great idea to organize the area. Dedicating this space for your student is part of developing their routine and will help them be successful throughout the year.

Routine

Establish a routine for your student(s). This will help them and you.

No matter how old your child or what type of material they are using, <u>track their progress</u> <u>regularly</u>. This allows you to help them stay on track. It also allows you to see which areas may need greater support and attention or which may need less time than anticipated.

The more time you invest planning and preparing at the beginning of the year and establishing a routine and expectations, the easier your year will be.

Make A Plan

Set a schedule together that works for you and your kids that will help them to stay in a routine.

Break the material down:

See how many total lessons and tests are in the year for

each subject

- Check the table of contents or overview to see how it is divided (lessons, units, etc.)
- · Count the total
- Divide that by how many weeks you are planning to homeschool (36 is average)
- Factor in any travel or vacation time


This gives you an idea of how many lessons/tests you need to get through each week to complete the year's

worth of work

Write down expectations:

Write down daily, weekly, and monthly, what is expected for completion for each class.

Share this with your student: they should know where they need to be and what needs to be accomplished for successful completion of each class.


