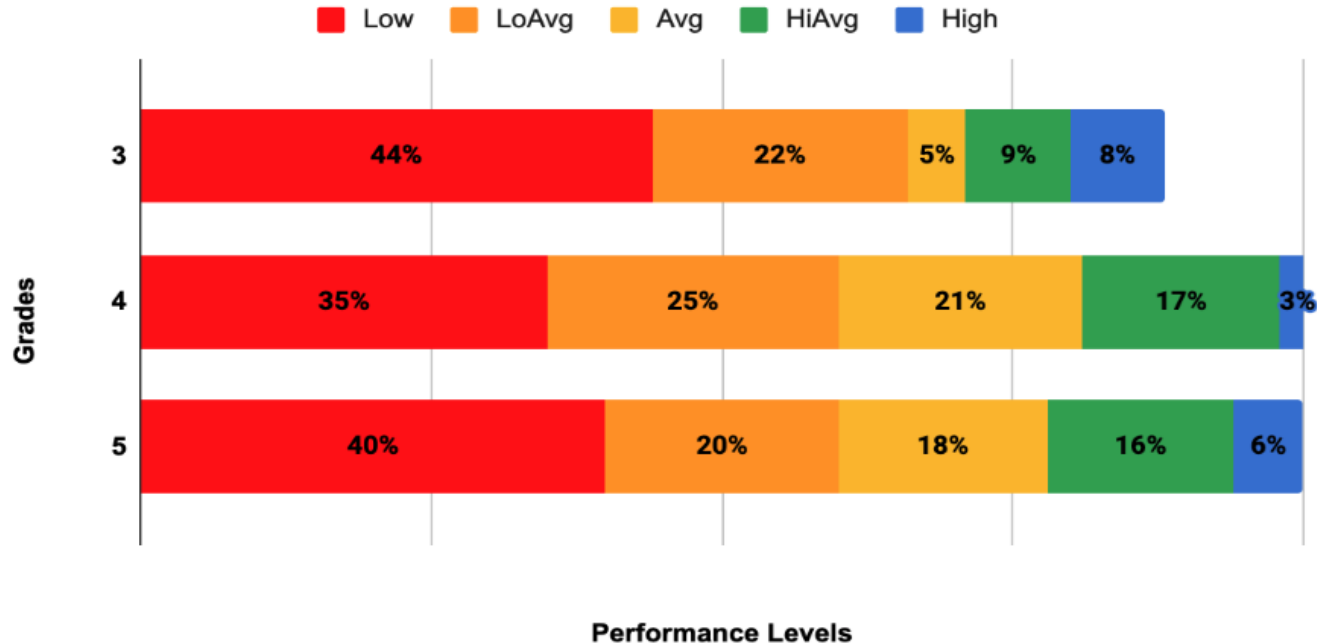
Rtl and Universal Screener DATA BY GRADE LEVEL

3-5 MOY NWEA MAP Reading

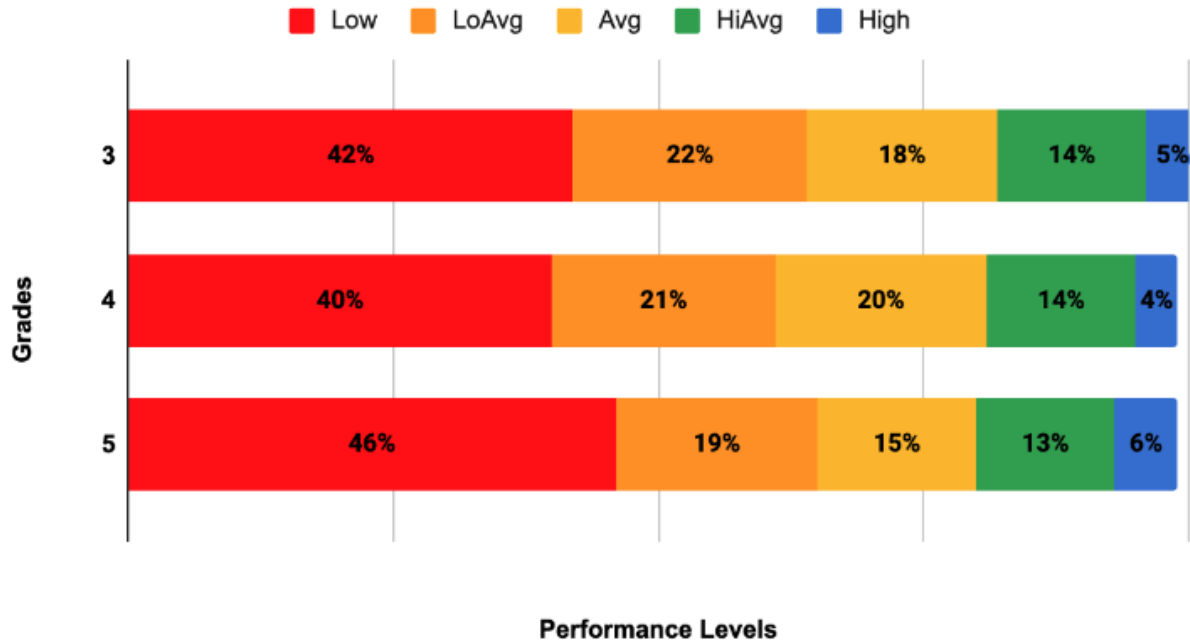

3-5 MOY NWEA MAP Math

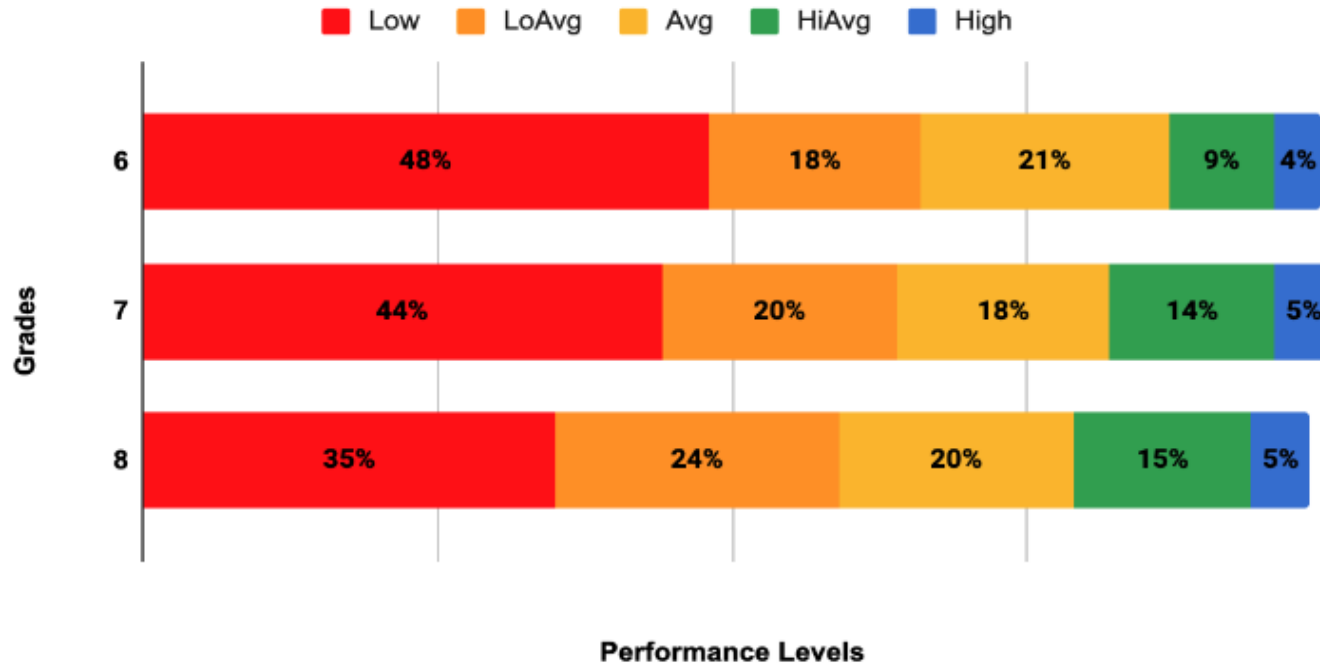

6-8 MOY NWEA MAP Reading

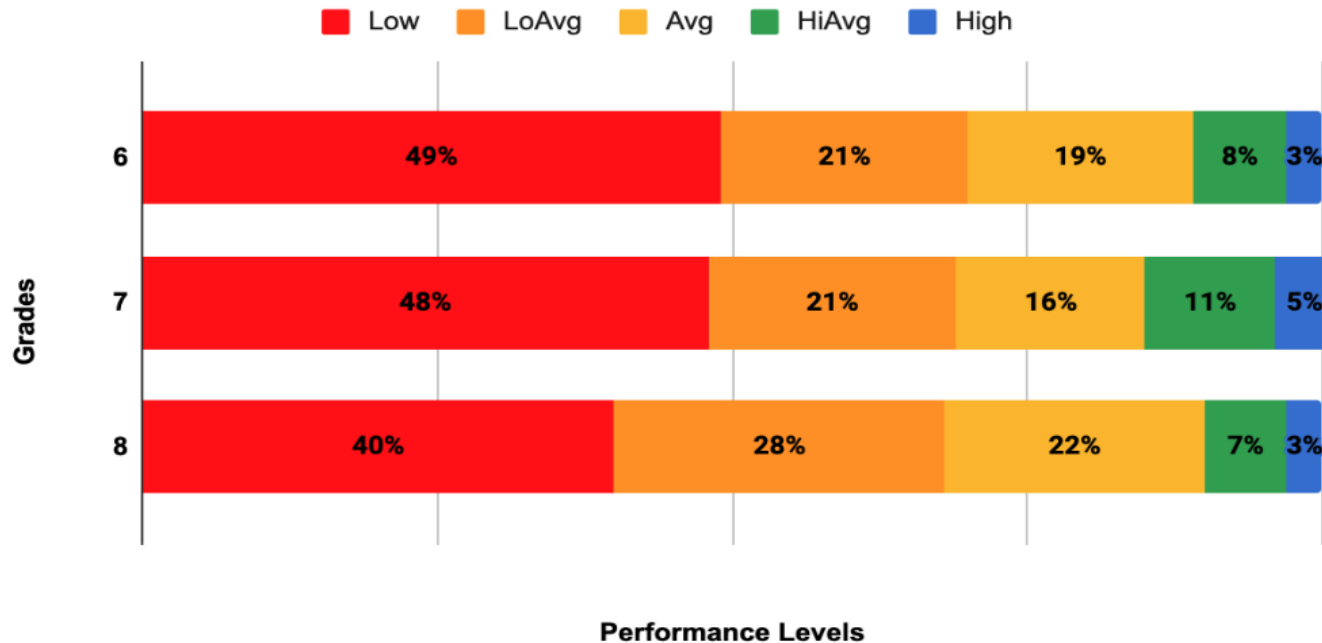
