Denton Independent School District New Denton High School Fine Arts Purchase

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Wenger Corporation in the amount of \$215,046.57 for the Fine Arts classroom furniture and equipment purchase for the new Denton High School.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This purchase will provide the classroom furniture and equipment for the newly constructed Denton High School Campus Fine Arts wing that is scheduled to be turned over to the District April 2022.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The classroom furniture and equipment will be purchased from Wenger Corporation through the local Denton ISD RFP #181-16 contract award. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the 2018 Bond Authorization.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the Fine Arts classroom furniture and equipment installed once the District receives temporary certificate of occupancy of the building.
