In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the 5th Cycle (February 22, 2016 – April 14, 2016).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 33 days (February 22 – April 14).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for the 5th cycle is 95.33%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 91.31% followed by 11th graders at 93.25%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade at 96.65% followed by 4th graders at 96.36% and the 6th graders were following closely at 96.32%.
- Comparison: 2015 5th grading cycle was 95.02
 2014 5th grading cycle was 95.6%
 2013 5th grading cycle was 95.92%.
