**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR SCHOOL BASED CLINIC CENTER BETWEEN BIRDVILLE ISD AND KELLER ISD**

**BOARD GOAL: The District will develop and promote positive community relations through effective communication, the involvement of stakeholders, and the establishment of community partnerships.**

**FISCAL NOTE: Donated Funds**

**Background Information:**

- In April 2007, KISD had approximately 4,190 economically disadvantaged students
- KISD has many families that do not qualify as economically disadvantaged that currently have no health insurance
- Students cannot reach their full academic potential unless they are physically and emotionally fit
- John Peter Smith Health Network (JPSHN) is a tax-supported network that serves low-income and underinsured families
- JPSHN provides school-based health clinics funded through a unique partnership between JPSHN and school districts
- JPSHN and Birdville ISD currently operate a school-based health clinic that would be easily accessible to KISD families

**Administrative Considerations:**

- Attached is the Memorandum of Understanding agreement creating a partnership with Birdville ISD and Keller ISD to provide KISD families access to the JPSHN/Birdville ISD School-based Health Center
- The agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's legal counsel
- Northwood Church has agreed to donate KISD's portion of the funds for the 07-08 school year

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**The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the Memorandum of Understanding and accept the \$500 monthly donation from Northwood Church as presented.**
