Personal Communication Devices	A student is prohibited from possessing or using a personal com- munication device on school property during the school day. A stu- dent who violates this policy or any regulations shall be subject to discipline in accordance with the Board-adopted Student Code of Conduct.	
	An authorized District employee shall confiscate a student's per- sonal communication device that is possessed in violation of this policy or any applicable regulations.	
	If a personal communication device is not retrieved, the District shall dispose of the device after providing the notice required by law.	
Exceptions	A student shall be authorized to possess and use a personal com- munication device on school property during the school day only under the following circumstances:	
	ta	he student's possession and use is necessary for implemen- ation of the student's individualized education program, a 504 lan, or a similar program or plan;
		he student's possession or use is required due to a docu- nented need based on a directive from a qualified physician; r
	а	he student's possession or use is necessary to comply with health or safety requirement imposed by law or as part of ne District or campus safety protocols.
Implementation	The Superintendent shall develop regulations to implement this policy.	
Compliance	Annually, the Superintendent shall report to the Board on the imple- mentation and compliance of this policy.
