Emergency Purchases-

BISD has elected to make an emergency purchase of two air conditioning units and 25 portable air conditioners for Champion High School as a result of two air conditioning units needing to be replaced two weeks prior to the start of school.

Per Education Code Chapter 44, Subchapter B, Section 44.031, (h): "If school equipment, a school facility, or a portion of a school facility is destroyed, severely damaged, or experiences a major unforeseen operational or structural failure, and the board of trustees determines that the delay posed by the contract methods required by this section would prevent or substantially impair the conduct of classes or other essential school activities, then contracts for the replacement or repair of the equipment, school facility, or portion of the school facility may be made by a method other than the methods required by this section."

Champion High School Air Conditioners-

Trane has been selected as the awarded vendor to provide two air conditioning units for CHS.

Sunbelt has been awarded as the vendor for BISD to purchase 25 portable air conditioners to use at CHS while the main units are being assembled. These units will then be distributed throughout the District and available for use.
