**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of 2,500 Windows RDS users' licenses, in the amount of \$39,875 from CDW-G REMC bid list.

The Microsoft remote desktop services product will allow LPS staff to access the CLASS A Remark software from any computer in the district and from any computer at home. This will allow teachers to scan their exams on the school copiers and make corrections from any computer.
