

<p>VII.</p>	<p><u>NEW COURSES FOR THE 2017-2018 PROGRAM OF STUDIES</u></p> <p><u>Literacy Lab</u> Grades 9-12 .5 Credit 01009 Language Arts Laboratory Language Arts Laboratory courses provide instruction in basic language skills, integrating reading, writing, speaking, and listening, while placing great emphasis on the progress of individual students. Course content depends upon students' abilities and may include vocabulary building, improving spelling and grammar, developing writing and composition skills, reading silently or aloud, and improving listening and comprehension abilities.</p> <p><u>Math Lab</u> Grades 9-12 .5 Credit 02049 Foundation Math This half -year course is designed to address mathematical standards that will better prepare students for success in core mathematics classes.
