RESOLUTION OPPOSING MEASURE 62: CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT ALLOCATES 15% OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS TO PUBLIC SAFETY FUND FOR CRIME PREVENTION, INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 62 would amend the Oregon Constitution to direct 15% of lottery proceeds to the establishment of a public safety fund for crime programs, criminal investigation, additional funding for police and sheriff departments, and at risk children programs; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 62 would redirect money currently used to fund an education stability fund and natural parks funding; and

WHEREAS, currently education is underfunded and the state lottery provides needed revenue for the education of all children in the state of Oregon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Parkrose Board of Directors opposes Ballot Measure 62 because it would divert needed funds away from one of its primary purposes which is to provide additional funding to Oregon schools.
