Overview and Final Results

A collaborative instrument designed by the departments of: Admission/Attendance/Dropout Recovery, Advanced Academics and Gifted and Talented Program, Athletics/Health Services, Bilingual/ESL/DUAL/Foreign Language, Career and Technology Education, Federal and State Compensatory Programs, Fine Arts, Information Technology, Instructional Accountability and Region One.

HB5 Community and Student Engagement

Overview:

What is House Bill 5?

HB 5 of the 83rd Texas Legislature Regular Session added Section 39.0545 to the Texas Education Code (TEC §39.0545) that requires each school district evaluate the district's performance and the performance of each campus in the district in community and student engagement and in compliance to state law and policy requirements. The district and each campus will assign a rating of Exemplary, Recommended, Acceptable or Unacceptable for both overall performance and for each individual factor listed below.

Individual Categories:

- (A) Fine Arts;
- (B) Wellness and Physical Education;
- (C) Community and Parental Involvement;
- (D) 21st Century Workforce Development Program;
- (E) Second Language Acquisition Program;
- (F) Digital Learning Environment;
- (G) Dropout Prevention Strategies;
- (H) Educational Programs for Gifted and Talented Students; and
- (I) Compliance to Statutory Reporting and Policy Requirements

Who will determine the rating criteria and the indicators for each category?

TEC § 39.0545 mandates that a local committee develop the criteria for evaluating the performance of the district's campus programs for each category. UISD developed a committee with representation from each feeder pattern and a sub-committee with representation from each director leading each of the categories to be evaluated. Committee and Subcommittee members provided feedback for the indicators to be evaluated and the information was transferred to an evaluation tool developed by Region One.

What process was used to evaluate each category for each campus and the district?

Each campus reviewed the information for each indicator in each category and assigned the rating based on the activities/information for this school year. The evaluation tool then assigned a value to the ratings of acceptable, recommended and exemplary to determine a combined value and calculate a final rating per category and the final overall rating.
