# **GSRP & Hillsdale County Preschool Joint Recruitment**

- Our School Readiness Advisory Committee will be holding a meeting on January 14, 2020, from 4:30 to 6:00 pm. #### Literacy

• Seven districts in the county are participating in the Kids Read Now program for the 2019-20 school year. Kids Read Now is a summer reading program that aims to eliminate the reading loss that occurs over the summer month referred to as "summer slide". In the program, students handpick nine books that are of interest to them to receive in the mail over the summer. Students are guaranteed six books with the potential to receive up to all nine that were selected. The program

follows these simple steps; students read the book, parents/guardians report that the book has been read, a new book is sent in the mail. Once a book is received in the mail it belongs to the student forever.
