The Board of Education Finance Committee met at 6:15 p.m. on Monday, April 14, 2025, at Coultrap Educational Services Center, 227 North Fourth Street, Geneva, Illinois.

4. DISCUSSION/CONSIDERATION

1. 2024-2025 Capital Improvement Projects Update Todd Latham shared an update on the 2024-25 capital improvement projects that were approved by the board on May 13, 2024. He shared that there were several projects executed in 2024-25 and several capital improvement projects from prior years. Projects completed to date in 2024-25 include:

Geneva High School - Burgess Field turf and track, boiler system, parking lot, concrete sidewalk/curb repairs

Geneva Middle Schools – concrete sidewalk/curb repairs

Fabyan Elementary School – hot water heater, tuckpointing, burner assembly upgrade to boilers

Harrison Street School - concrete sidewalk/curb repairs

Heartland Elementary School – flooring replacement, roof elastomeric coating, concrete sidewalk/curb repairs

Mill Creek Elementary School – boiler replacement, emergency back-up generator, paving for playground area

Western Avenue Elementary School – unit ventilator, boiler replacement, emergency back-up generator

Williamsburg Elementary School – hot water heater

Coultrap Educational Services Center – parking lot

Kesinger Bus Garage – parking lot, HVAC & air compressor

There are still projects that should be completed by June 30, 2025. To date, the district has paid \$10,377,306 for capital improvement projects during the 2024-25 school year. It is projected that the district could pay another \$1,134,222 by June 30, 2025.
