Teen Truth Presentation at Middle School and High School

- Aligns with Whole Child pillar of the strategic plan
- Addressed school culture and mental health from a student perspective
- Follow up from JC Pohl that presented to staff at the beginning of the school year.

Convened assemblies for both middle school and high school students with <u>Caleb</u> <u>Campbell</u> from Teen Truth. Caleb specializes in mental health presentations for students.

Followed up with a Student Summit with a group of 70 students from grades 6-12 to address from a student perspective challenges within our school community as well as to develop solutions to address those challenges. Student solutions and ideas are now being taken to building PBIS teams to review and determine feasible options to implement. Then these options will be taken back to the student teams to determine the implementation process.
