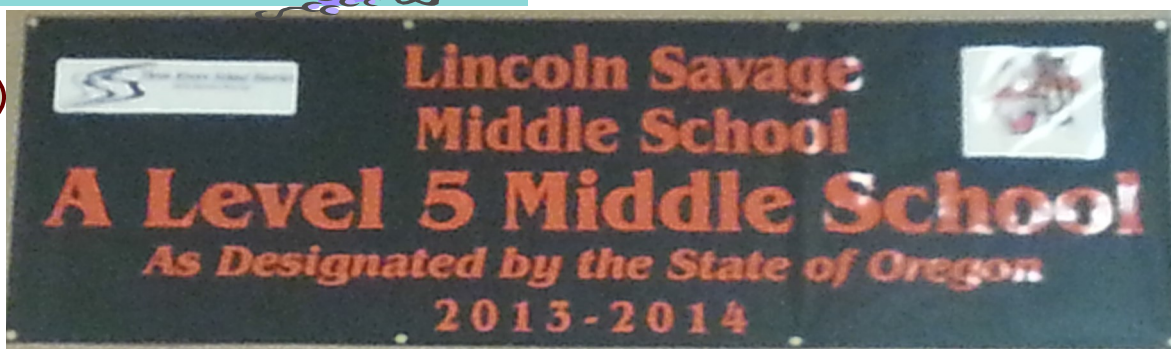




TIGER TIMES

Students are learning the skills of responsibility and respect when they keep track of their library materials. Fines and overdues can keep a student from participating in certain school events.

-This year, we have brand-new Language Arts textbooks which are black. Please make sure you take very good care of them (bookcovers are nice)! There will also be a replacement fee for any accompanying workbooks that become lost.

-A.R.: Students can find books online at home or school by searching *AR Bookfind*, then logging in to Renaissance Learning. Here, you may check on book titles and see if there is an AR test available and what reading level it is.

Parents: Please pick up your Parent Home Connect paperwork during conferences from your child's Language Arts teacher. All instructions and student passwords will be on this paper concerning A.R. testing and book selections that your student has read so far this school year.

6th Grade Field Trip:

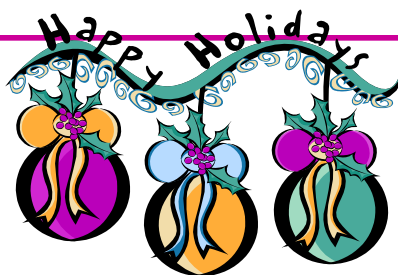
