Background Information:

- The project is being developed as Construction Manager at Risk delivery method.
- The project is a prototype site adapt.

Administrative Considerations:

- Growth necessitates the school to open in 2007. For fall completion, plans are typically submitted for permits in June.
- Four proposals were received and evaluated, based on published district criteria.
- Proposers were ranked as follows:
 - 1. Steele-Freeman, Inc.
 - 2. Pogue Construction Company
 - 3. Hunt Construction Group
 - 4. Goldsmith Construction Company
- These rankings and the methodology used by the administration to evaluate and rank the proposals have been reviewed and approved by the Facilities Committee.

The administration and Steele-Freeman have negotiated a total fee, including overhead, indirect costs, soft costs, and profit of \$782,691, which is \$14,000 less than the total in Steele Freeman's principal proposal.

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The administration recommends selection of Steele-Freeman, Inc. for the Construction Manager at Risk for the New Elementary #19.
