Leadership

Leadership is involved in many activities here at LSMS. One of the most important activities is the "Buddy Program". Leaders are assigned to younger students to work alongside of their "Buddy" to help them both academically and socially. New students to LSMS are also assigned a leadership student to help show them the ropes. Leadership students meet with their buddies twice a week during 6th and 7th periods and will meet with them before school and during passing periods.

Leadership students also work with the PBIS team to sponsor and put on PBIS activities. Leadership students were responsible for creating the PBIS activities and running those activities on Jan. 31st. They also oversaw the PBIS activity for Feb. 28th and will assist with the end of trimester activity.

Leadership students contacted the "Protectors", an anti-bullying group, and sponsored Paul Coughlin to come and give an anti-bullying message to the students at LSMS. They also invited 12 other schools from around the district and Grant Pass to participate in the assembly.

Leadership students raised over \$1600 dollars during Valentines week for the leadership fund to send leadership students to the OASC conference in Portland at the end of April.

Leadership students ran the coin drive in December. The money collected was used to help families in our Lincoln Savage community.



Leadership students participated after school in the HV FBLA Boot Camp to learn about non-profits and to compete for \$1500 dollars to give to a non-profit organization of their choosing.
