Youth Enrichment:

- Glee Club (3-6th): 24 participants. They will perform at the spring concert on May 10th.
- Youth Dance (prek-6th): 89 participants. They will perform on May 5th.
- Bottle Rockets: upcoming on Monday, April 23, still taking registrations

Youth Recreation:

- Spring Youth Soccer (K-6th): 109 participants. Practices are Mondays, April 9-May 14. Scrimmage dates/times: Saturdays, April 14-May 19.

Upcoming Planning: The Spring-Summer Brochure went out the first week of April. We are currently taking registrations for all programs offered in the brochure. Adult Enrichment:

- Permit to Carry Classes: Ongoing
- 55+ Driving Classes: Refresher 4 Hour class held on April 10 from 12:30-4:30 P.M. There were 18 participants. 8 Hour Initial class scheduled for April 14 canceled due to low enrollment.
- Wood Pallet Sign: partnership with Root River Floral on April 14. There are 11 participants signed up.

Adult Recreation:

- Pickleball: Tuesday evenings. The last evening for this event will be Tuesday, April 17.
- Adult open gym: Wednesdays through March. They averaged 10 per open gym.
- Hall Walking: we have 35 signed up.
- Adult Barre Exercise Class: beginning April 5 with 12 participating.

Kids' Club Highlights:

- Average morning numbers for March: 13
- Average afternoon numbers for March: 29
- We were open on March 16 for the Kindergarten Registration day (Kindergartners did not have school). We had 7 sign up for the all day care.
- We will be open for the early out on April 26th (due to P/T Conferences) but will be closed on April 27 (no school day).

Early Childhood Screening: We held our spring EC Screening on Friday, April 6th. We had 9 students participate in the screening. We hold two screenings per year, and the amount to be screened are determined by the students' date of birth.

Lille By Preschool:

- We are currently taking registrations for 2018-19 school year. Currently we have 36 priority registrations and 22 additional registrations for a total of 58 so far. This is a great start to our 2018-19 school year. Unfortunately, we will have to do a lottery drawing for our morning 4/5 year old class as many have requested mornings, however we have limited space. We will be informing parents by the end of the month.
- Our current preschool classes are going well. They will have their annual field trip to Johnson Rolling Acres on April 25.

ECFE:

- Classes are going well on both Monday evenings and Friday mornings.
- The annual Daddy/Daughter Dance is April 22 from noon-2 P.M.
- We will be sending out another ECFE newsletter with some summer offerings for our preschool students.
