The start of a new year seems like a great time to reflect on where we've been and where we're heading. Below is a statistical summary of those things we can quantify. Much else of course is less amenable to stats. Thank you for all you do to support our staff, students and school community!

Student Behavior:

As of 18 December, we have had 71 discipline referrals this year.

In 2008-09, we had 71 referrals by 03 November.

In 2007-08, we had 71 referrals by 21 September.

Academic Performance:

Reading: 2005 -- 52% M/E; 2009 -- 69% M/E (up 17 points -- above state average)

Math: 2005 -- 42% M/E; 2009 -- 49% M/E (up 7 points -- below state average)

Science: 2005 -- 55% M/E; 2009 -- 64% M/E (up 9 points -- above state average)

Writing: 2005 -- 40% M/E; 2009 -- 50% M/E (up 10 points -- below state average)

(We were above state in all areas in 2008 but had massive OAKS and tech problems last year)
