## Talented and Gifted Programs and Services

The District is committed to an educational program that recognizes, identifies, and serves the unique needs of talented and gifted (TAG) learners. The District has identified the following educational goals for TAG students:

Talented and gifted students will receive instruction at the appropriate rate and level to ensure continued intellectual development and engagement.

Talented and gifted students will be provided high-level tasks that develop advanced critical thinking skills utilizing a wide array of instructional materials to challenge or extend existing ideas and to develop new ideas.

Talented and gifted students will develop personal and academic goals in collaboration with teachers and parents that address their specific areas of giftedness. A Plan & Profile will be created for each child with individual goals that can be monitored electronically by all stakeholders.

Talented and gifted students will have learning opportunities to work with intellectual peers and opportunities to form positive relationships with a diverse community.

Talented and gifted students are those who have been identified as academically talented and/or intellectually gifted.

The Board directs the superintendent to develop a written identification process for identifying academically talented and intellectually gifted students K-12.

A written plan that identifies programs or services needed to address the assessed levels of learning and accelerated rates of learning of identified students shall be similarly developed.

The Superintendent will establish TAG Program Standards that will ensure the appropriate educational services for identified students and procedures for individual questions, concerns, or complaints regarding the identification or services provided for identified talented and gifted students.
