INFORMATIONAL REPORT:
Administration will present proposed boundary changes effective the 2024-2025 school year. These boundary changes are necessary due to the opening of Juan Roberto Middle School and will have an impact on the student population at George Washington Middle School.
With the approval of the 2013 bond program, the District planned and has built a new middle school in the Mines Road area to alleviate George Washington Middle School who has a current enrollment of 1,093 and has 20 portable classrooms (10 portable buildings) to accommodate this enrollment.
Staff will invite the parents of those students affected with the proposed boundary changes to a meeting to be held during November at George Washington Middle School to explain the proposed boundaries for the new campus.
