## SELF-INSURANCE RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Board of Trustees acknowledges its obligations under Texas Education Code 22.08. and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorizes a self-insurance plan for group medical and prescription insurance for the benefit of district employees, and;

WHEREAS, the District contributes a certain amount towards the medical premium while the employee pays the difference between the medical premium and the district contribution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Trustees of United Independent School District has reviewed the funding of the liability assumed. Any deficits occurring in the Group Health Fund for the school year 2018-19 will be covered by the district's general operation funds.
